STANDARDIZED TESTING SCHEDULES

There is no question that academics come first and foremost for all students. In the case of standardized testing and conflicts with the 2025 competitive marching band schedule, the following has been arranged:

SATs

- August 23 This is the morning of our last day of band camp and Family/Friends performance, **please avoid.**
- September 13 This is a camp day before competitions, **schedule this one!**
- October 4 This is a show day. **Please avoid scheduling SATs for this date.**
- November 2 This is the rain date for State Championships, please avoid if possible.
- December 6 No conflict, **please try to schedule SATs for this day.**

PSATs

- October 11 Students will be able to take test and then attend marching band.

ACTs

- September 6 This is on Suckasunny Day, please avoid if possible.
- October 25 This is the day of the NJMBDA Regional, **please avoid this date!**

ALL-STATE CHOIR/ORCHESTRA SCHEDULES

Students who are accepted to an All-State ensemble are excused from one rehearsal due to a conflict. We will discuss which rehearsal to miss when results are released. Students are expected to arrive to marching band at the conclusion of the remaining rehearsals.

RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS

Religious observances are considered an excused absence at the. Students are expected to communicate conflicts and concerns in a timely fashion.

GENERAL FALL SCHEDULE STATEMENT

Much of the band's success depends on **individual ownership** of the Band Calendar. It is the responsibility of each individual student to be aware of the calendar. You can find a digital calendar as well as updates and reminders on our website. Please reference the attendance policy if you have any questions regarding potential conflicts.

POLICIES

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. The use and/or possession of alcohol, cigarettes, e-cigarettes, drugs, or drug-like substances will not be tolerated. Any student found to be in violation of this rule would face immediate administrative and legal action.
2. Students will be prompt about adhering to the times listed on the schedule, and avoid any conflicts with this schedule. This includes Marching Gaels, Roxbury Sound, and Pep Band responsibilities.
3. Destruction and/or damage of school owned or outside property will not be tolerated. It will be the responsibility of the guilty party and or parties to pay for, replace, and/or repair any damage.
4. Disrespect towards any staff member, chaperone, or authority figure will not be tolerated.
5. Students will treat all peers in a respectful and honorable manner.
6. Students will prepare oneself in the areas of music and drill before rehearsal so that the ensemble rehearsal can be a positive and motivating experience for all involved.
7. Students will bring a positive attitude to rehearsals, despite personal problems or conflicts with other members. As such, students will behave in a manner that will bring dignity upon the entire band program.
8. Students are solely responsible for their equipment and possessions. The school holds no liability whatsoever for lost or stolen items.
9. In addition to the above, all school rules will be in effect. Students should clearly understand that they are a representative of Roxbury High School and the Roxbury High School Instrumental Music Department and therefore are expected to behave in a mature and exemplary manner. Respect for one another and themselves is imperative.

STUDENTS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THE ABOVE WILL POTENTIALLY FACE:

- **ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION**
- **EXPULSION FROM THEIR PERFORMING ENSEMBLE**
- **ACTION BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES**
- **CONTACT OF PARENTS OR GUARDIANS TO ARRANGE FOR IMMEDIATE TRANSPORTATION HOME AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE**

THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS OF MONIES PAID AS A RESULT OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION!

ATTENDANCE POLICY

In order to have a high quality, Varsity-Level marching band, attendance from all members is essential. *Work schedules, trips, and other unapproved activities must not interfere* with the rehearsal and long range performance schedule that you are given at the beginning of the season. Participation in the Marching Gaels and another approved RHS Fall sport or activity is allowed only at the discretion of the directors. If the other activity significantly interferes with the marching season schedule, a choice will have to be made. If you are hoping to participate in another school activity, please plan on having a conversation with a director upon Marching Gaels registration. Be prepared with a complete semester calendar from any other activities so you can compare schedules to see if things are possible. If your activity is approved, please remember that other groups, organizations, or businesses that may change schedules or make demands of students on short notice will not be allowed to interfere with the long-range rehearsal and performance schedule of the marching band. Please observe the following policies and procedures:

Approved Activity Shared Schedule Considerations -

- Students must follow agreed-upon shared schedules
- Any unforeseen conflicts MUST be communicated to the directors as soon as they become known
- In the event of a sport/activity practice or game cancellation, students should report to marching band rehearsal if scheduled
- In the event that a sport practice is moved to a scheduled marching band time, students must communicate with Mr. Sweer immediately and work together to find a suitable way to swap times so they may still be at an equivalent number of marching band practices. If this is not possible, marching band must take precedent as rehearsal time compared to sports is limited.
- If a sports game is moved to a scheduled marching band competition time, students must communicate with Mr. Sweer immediately and work together to figure out if there is a way to make both work within the confines of the competition-day schedule. If there is no way, students are expected to attend the marching competition as it was the originally-scheduled event for the day.

Pep Band Attendance - All Marching Gaels are expected to go to away games. With advanced notice, and at the director's discretion, a student may be excused from one away game. Student leaders and Drum Majors are expected to attend all away games.

Attendance Check will begin promptly at the start of rehearsal in the basics block.

Schedule Listed Times - Times listed in the schedule or in communications are start and end times of the rehearsal. Once rehearsal is over, students are usually given announcements and then expected to help clean up and move instruments and other equipment to their designated locations before having down time. We will make this happen as quickly as possible, but your patience and understanding of all that goes into the schedule and program is appreciated.

Tardiness

Students not in the attendance block in their assigned position at the appropriate time will be marked tardy. The student must upon arrival explain to the director the reason for tardiness. Tardiness will be excused at the discretion of the directors. All tardies will be converted to a mark of absence 15 minutes after the rehearsal begins. Students who acquire two unexcused tardies shall be subject to the consequences equivalent to one absence as outlined below.

Participation in Roxbury Sound-Only

This designation is reserved for students in EMS, or approved RHS students who have a legitimate schedule conflict. Choosing this option on the registration form will initiate a conversation with a director who will ultimately make the decision whether or not to allow Sound-only participation.

The following are *examples* of **Absences** that will be considered excused and unexcused:

Excused Absence

- Approved RHS fall sports/activities that follow the agreed upon schedule
- Personal illness requiring medical attention
- Death or Wedding in the family
- Other serious problems

Unexcused Absence

- Attending Concerts, Performances, Sporting Events
- Attending Comic-Con, E3, or similar Conferences
- Family Events outside of Weddings or Funerals
- Student Babysitting or Work Responsibilities
- Other Organization's Competitions, Festivals, Fundraising Events, and Schedule Changes

UNEXCUSED ABSENCES will be subject to the following at the discretion of the directors:

- 1st Offense: Loss of 3rd quarter break privileges for one game
- 2nd Offense: Loss of bus privilege and no 3rd quarter break for one game
- 3rd Offense: Removal from the marching band

Unexcused absence from a Saturday rehearsal will result in accumulation of TWO unexcused absences

ANY ABSENCE YOU WISH TO BE EXCUSED MUST BE COMMUNICATED TO THE DIRECTORS AHEAD OF TIME. PLEASE RESPECT THE PROGRAM AND THE SCHEDULE BY SETTING UP APPOINTMENTS, EXTRA ACADEMIC HELP, OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES, ETC OUTSIDE OF REHEARSAL TIME. COMMUNICATION IS KEY!

MEDIA POLICY

Throughout the season, the Roxbury Marching Bands will take photos and videos of students for use in promotional materials, social media, and other band-related content. We follow the media consent guidelines set by Roxbury Public Schools. If a student does not wish to be included in photos or videos, it is their responsibility to ensure their media permissions are updated with the district.

MARCHING BAND UNIFORM GUIDELINES

Students are expected to follow the listed uniform guidelines. No variations will be allowed.

This uniform is the apparel that identifies you as a Marching Band member. It must be **ALWAYS** be worn properly.

General Uniform Information

- Students will be issued a number for their uniform and shako. This number should be memorized or recorded in a readily accessible location. Students will use this number to pick up their uniform and shako from the storage room.
- Only the uniform parents or a director may hand out a uniform: Students may not enter the uniform storage room to pick up a uniform.
- The uniform must be hung up correctly on its return or you will be sent to the end of the line. Students who are unaware of how to hang up their uniform properly should ask a section leader or student leader for assistance.

Uniform Parts

- **Assigned Uniform:** Every band member will be assigned a uniform including a set of bib pants, jacket, gauntlets, gloves, shoes, shakos, and plume. These uniforms shall NOT go home with a band member. In the event a piece of the uniform is lost, the band member will be responsible for the replacement cost. The entire uniform costs approximately \$550.
- **Band "R" or Show T-Shirt:** (all students) This is to be worn under the marching coat. **NO TANK TOPS.** These shirts will be provided for you at Band Camp. (During the colder months long undergarments such as Under Armor can be worn underneath your uniform and t-shirt, but the t-shirt MUST be the top layer under the uniform). "R"-shirts will be worn for any Roxbury Sound or Pep Band activity. Show shirts for any Marching Gaels activity.
- **Shako:** (Gaels only) The adjustable chinstrap is to be worn at all times. The chinstrap should be adjusted so that the shako does not fall back while playing or at attention. **The helmet/shako is NEVER to be worn backwards and must be carried as demonstrated by your section leader.**
- **Plume:** (Gaels only) The plume is fastened into the shako by simply inserting it into the plume holder and pushing it down. To take the plume off of the shako, pinch the wire at the base of the plume while pulling it off. Plumes will be distributed and collected before and after every performance.
- **Gloves:** (Gaels only) White & Black marching band gloves are distributed in the high school band uniform room **before** performances. Gloves must be **CLEAN** and in good condition. Gloves will be collected after each performance. All wind players must wear gloves at performances.
- **Gauntlets:** (Gaels only) Gauntlets are distributed in the high school band uniform room **before** performances. Gauntlets must be **CLEAN** and in good condition. Gauntlets will be collected after each performance.

- **Drill Masters:** (all students) marching shoes with a rolled heel are purchased separately and are to be worn at all performances. Shoes must be polished before all performances. Only **PLAIN BLACK** socks are to be worn with the marching band uniform. **BLACK** socks must be high cut. NO LOW-CUT socks. **If marching shoes cannot be obtained due to financial reasons, please contact Mr. Sweer as soon as possible.**
- Color Guard will receive all uniform information from the color guard staff.
- **Roxbury Sound members are not responsible for gloves, gauntlets, shakos, or plumes.**

Care of the Marching Uniform

Proper care of the uniform is essential. Members must pride themselves in taking good care of school equipment. When the Roxbury High School Marching Band performs, the visual impact must be as great as the musical impact. This means that each and every member must do their utmost to ensure that the uniform stays clean and that shoes are polished. **If your uniform needs cleaning between games please inform the parent helper when returning your uniform.**

Marching Band Performance Grooming (Gaels)

To insure the clean, uniform appearance of the Marching Band, the following grooming regulations will be STRICTLY adhered to:

- Hair shall be worn off the uniform collar and behind the ears. Band members may choose to meet these requirements by either cutting the hair to a manageable length or putting hair up in such a way that it will not fall down when the helmet/shako is taken off. When the latter choice is made, band members must use a hair net, bobby pins, or other inconspicuous devices to hold hair in place through the entire performance, day or evening. Bright colored mesh hairnets and other noticeable devices are prohibited.
- **Jewelry (earrings, bracelets, rings, watches, sunglasses, etc.) WILL NOT BE WORN WHILE IN UNIFORM.**
- Makeup worn while in uniform must be modest and simple. Students who do not follow this policy will be asked to wash off their makeup off before leaving. Color guard members are exempt from this policy, as specific makeup will be used as part of the color guard uniform.
- Students may not wear extra layers of clothing under the uniform besides long undergarments thin pants/shorts, and an "R"-Shirt or Show shirt. (example: jeans, sweat pants, sweat shirts, hoodies, etc.). The t-shirt must be the top layer under the uniform.
- Each section leader will inspect his/her section before every performance. Band members will make certain that all of the above criteria are met and will double check to see if the shoes, uniform, and other equipment of her/his section are acceptable.
- The uniform must be worn in its entirety unless otherwise decided by the director, from the time the band leaves RHS to the moment they return. Students may NOT change into regular clothes while away unless otherwise instructed by a director.
- The section leaders and director will take action should any of these criteria not be met. Pending review through the chain of command, members not conforming to these guidelines will not be permitted to participate until these guidelines are met.
- All modifications including, but not limited to, face paint, glitter, hair ribbons, and extreme makeup are strictly prohibited.

Uniform Decorum

Marching Gaels

- Always wear and treat your uniform with pride. The uniform should be worn as a complete unit at all times when in public, except the shako. The only exception to this will be when a director instructs you that you may remove your shako or jacket.
- While wearing the Roxbury Marching uniform, you are a representative of the Roxbury Band program and Roxbury High School. You are expected to exercise common sense and good judgment while in uniform at all times, while exuding the pride our organization has for itself.
- While in full uniform, there is absolutely no: PDA, eating, smoking, swearing, or running.

Roxbury Sound & Pep Band

- For football games, Roxbury Sound members are not responsible for gloves, gauntlets, shakos, or plumes.
- Winter hats, gloves, and scarves are permitted in the stands. The directors may ask students to leave those items in the stands for the halftime performance, depending on the circumstances.
- Roxbury Sound students must be very careful to keep the uniform clean while eating during the third quarter.
- Face paint, hair bows, glitter, and other enhancements are permissible for the Roxbury Sound at the discretion of the directors.

* It is our intent that no student be denied participation in instrumental music programs due to financial hardship. Should you find yourself in this situation, we ask that you contact a band director for a confidential discussion of circumstances and options.

** Upon graduation, any remaining credit in a student's fundraising account will be absorbed into the general BPA account; alternatively, a student may elect to transfer the credit to a sibling or another specific band student in the program. Fundraised monies may not be 'refunded' to the student, only transferred within the organization.

Effective – July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026

7. Students will bring a positive attitude to rehearsals, despite personal problems or conflicts with other members. As such, students will behave in a manner that will bring dignity upon the entire band program.
8. Students are solely responsible for their equipment and possessions. The school holds no liability whatsoever for lost or stolen items.
9. In addition to the above, all school rules will be in effect. Students should clearly understand that they are a representative of Roxbury High School and the Roxbury High School Instrumental Music Department and therefore are expected to behave in a mature and exemplary manner. Respect for one another and themselves is imperative.
